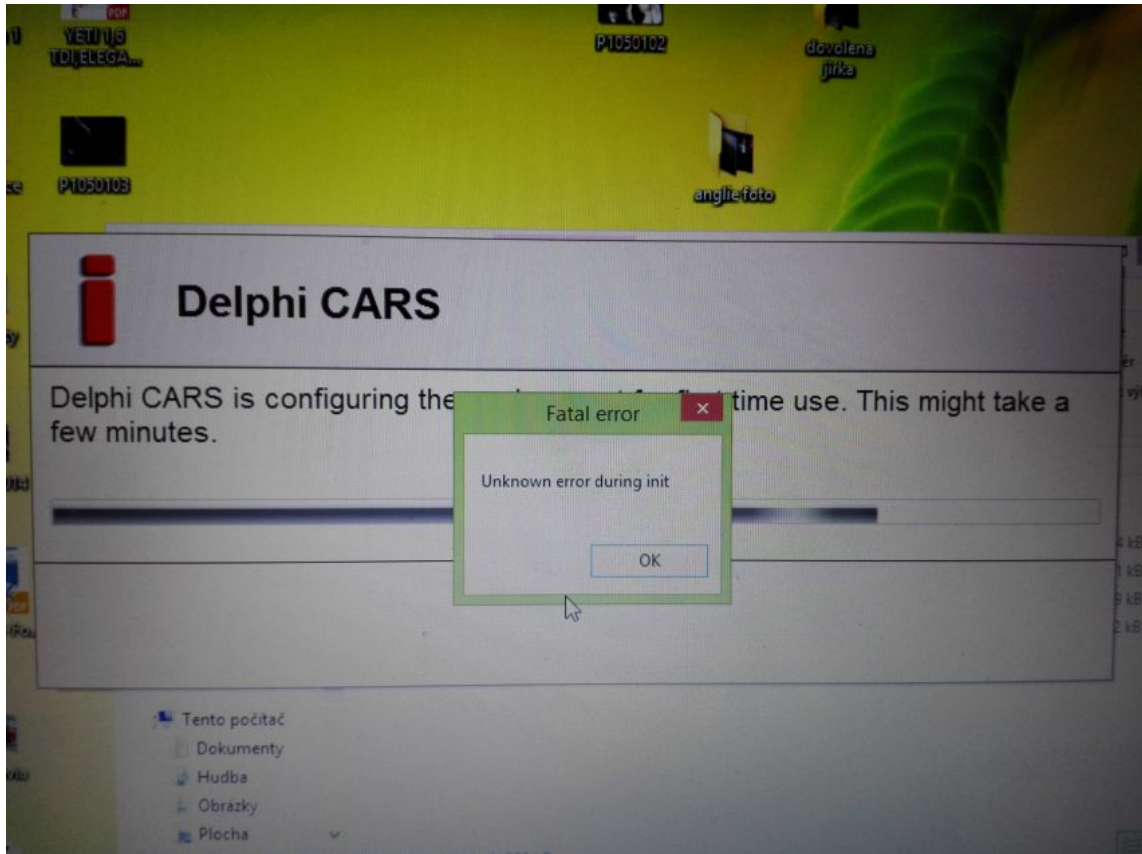

" if you want to try this, please be patient. it can take some time. he's asking on #fedora Ben64: i'm not sure how fedora + gnome stack. but this is ubuntu. you're not trying to boot a fedora, you're trying to fix a ubuntu problem i don't even know what this ubuntu package is called ;) maybe check dmesg for the reason nah, fedora+gnome is nothing like ubuntu+gnome, and this is a ubuntu 17.10, not a fedora. unless i'm missing something tomreyn, do you happen to know of a way to 'un-blacklist' that proprietary driver (think I got it by talking to a wrong person earlier;) - there is a mention of blacklisting in the error; guiverc: no, sorry. you don't happen to know of a way to blacklist back (remove) the xenial packages while still on xenial (16.04)? tomreyn, ^ guiverc: i'm not on 16.04, don't know how you can blacklist the xenial packages on 16.04 but 16.04 is supported for only 9 months. i don't think there's a way to bring back the non-blacklisted packages to 16.04. i'm using 17.10 i can go to 16.04

to install packages (or re-installing 17.10;..) i guess it would be possible to bring back the kernel to 16.04. but it's likely not very easy or smart. unless you're ready to make changes to configuration files, and then to reboot into it. and there's also support for 5 years maybe i'll try it. i'm wondering if it will result in 82157476af
